

12th Annual Florida Heterocyclic and Synthetic IUPAC-Sponsored Conference (FloHet-12)

Organized by ARKAT USA, Inc. and the University of Florida, Department of Chemistry

at the J. Wayne Reitz Union, University of Florida, Gainesville, FL, USA*

The conference will feature lectures and courses on heterocyclic and synthetic chemistry. This meeting should be of interest to those in academic or industrial research particularly in the pharmaceutical, agricultural and custom chemicals areas.

There will be eleven plenary lectures in six sessions given by experts from academia and industry, and three morning sessions each comprised of a choice from two parallel invited lecture sessions or short courses on heterocyclic/synthetic chemistry. There will also be two more parallel invited lecture sessions in the afternoons.

The conference includes a Poster Session (submissions are welcome) with a prize for the best poster. Chemical companies and publishers will exhibit their products and books.

Registration fees of \$1400 Industrial, \$750 Academic, \$500 Students or Postdoctorals will include a Welcome Party, lunches, coffee and tea breaks on 7th, 8th, 9th, a buffet dinner on Monday, wine reception on Tuesday and a Farewell Party on Wednesday. Complimentary wine will be served at all evening functions. **Special Package** - \$2000 one faculty member plus 3 students or postdoctorals.

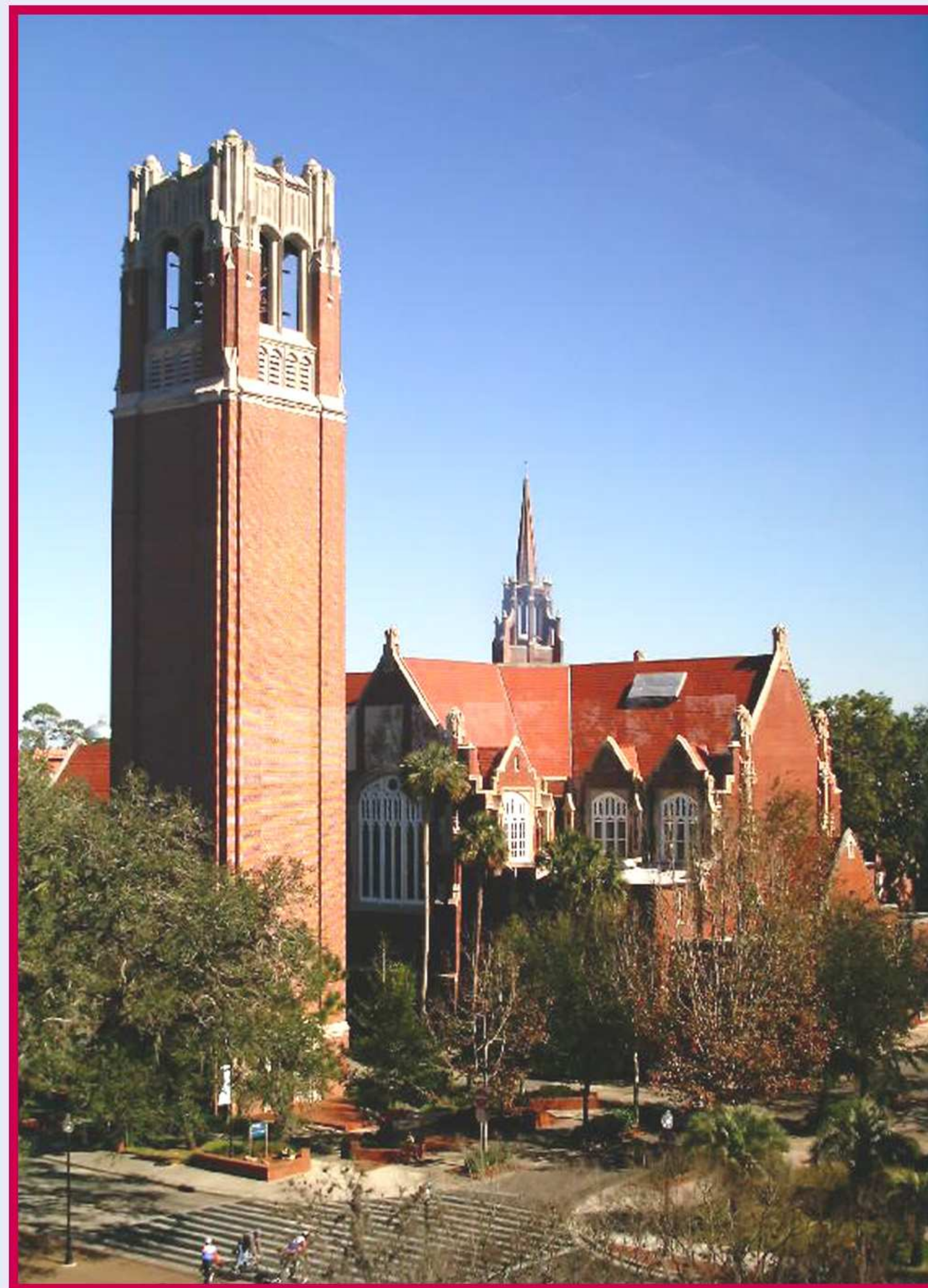
